Vision and values

We are a small school with a BIG heart.

Our Witchampton Wows

We have four Witchampton 'Wows'. Each of the Wows represent one of the school values: Love (pink); Courage (orange); British Values (turquoise), and Inspiration (purple). The children are awarded a Wow that represents the value that they have excelled in. For example, to be awarded a 'Love' Wow, a child may show great companionship towards a fellow pupil when they are unwell; for 'Courage', a child may try something for the first time, and for 'Inspiration' a child may have completed a great piece of work that was shared with the class / whole school.

Clubs

At lunchtimes and after school children can make use a variety of clubs that we run. Some are offered by a teacher or sports coach funded by the school, and others are externally run, which require a small charge.

These include our singing club, recorder club, computer club, netball club, farm animals club, Reverend Suzie's club, rounders club, drama club, science club, karate club, gymnastics club and multi-sports club.



Music

Music is a unique way of communicating that can inspire and motivate children. It is a vehicle for personal expression, and it can play an important part in the personal development of people.

We provide a variety of opportunities for all children to create, play, perform and enjoy music, to develop the skills to appreciate a wide variety of musical forms, and to begin to make judgements about the quality of music.

Outside the classroom

Our school includes exciting outside areas where children can play and explore. We go on trips – and we're small enough that sometimes we take the whole school. Children play sport on our field and we always aim to keep them healthy through diet and exercise.
