


E was asked to write out the numbers 1 to 10.... but she kept going! All the way up to 26...




Planting potatoes in the vegetable plot





Entertaining family with a puppet show! She helped her Grandma to make and decorate the puppet theatre out of a big cardboard box.





Drawing a portrait of Mummy!










Great help preparing the toppings, by grating the cheese and cutting the ham safely with a knife, and then using the ingredients to top our homemade pizzas
