A lovely card for Mummy



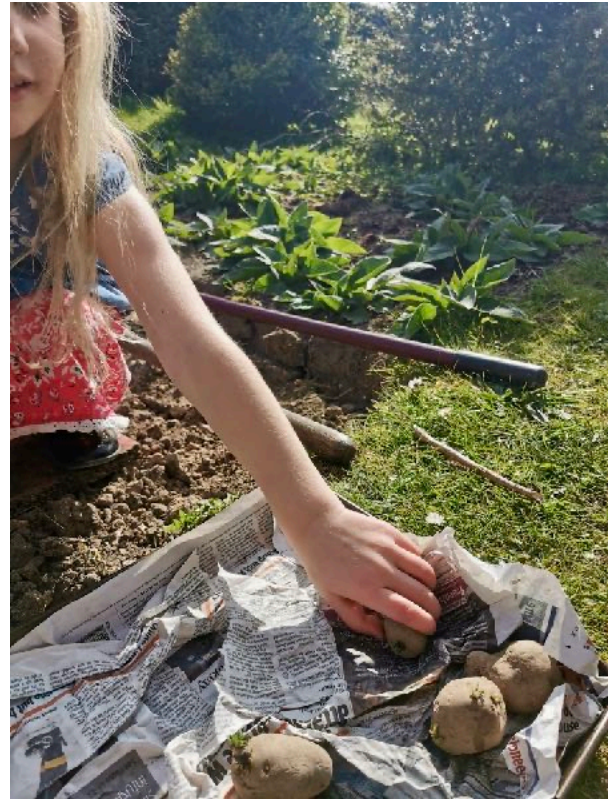
Ready for stargazing with Daddy - they learned about several constellations and even spotted a shooting star!







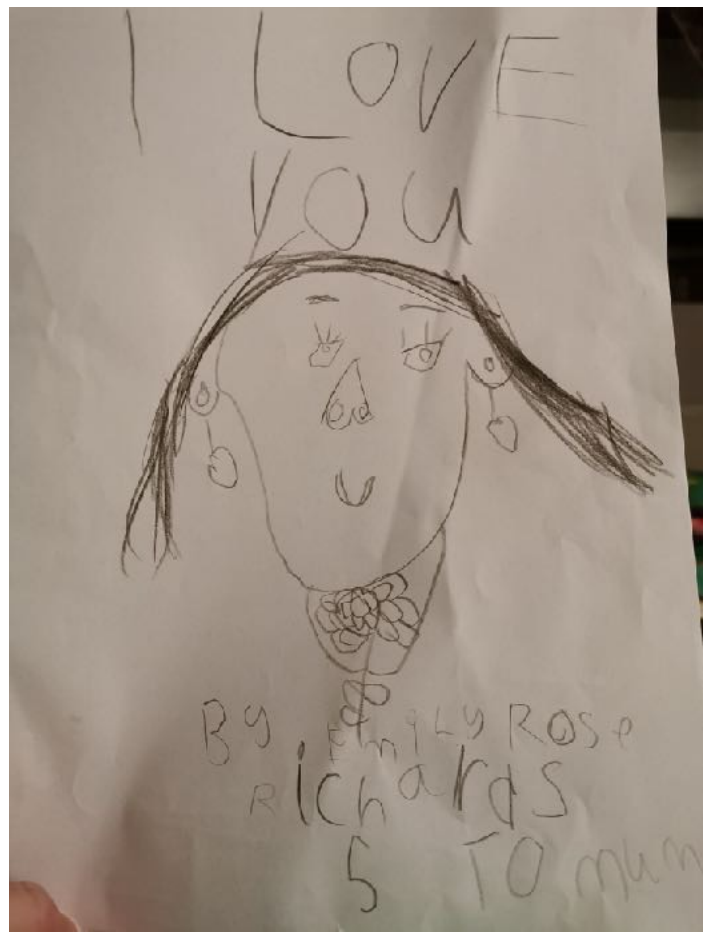

Planting potatoes in the vegetable plot

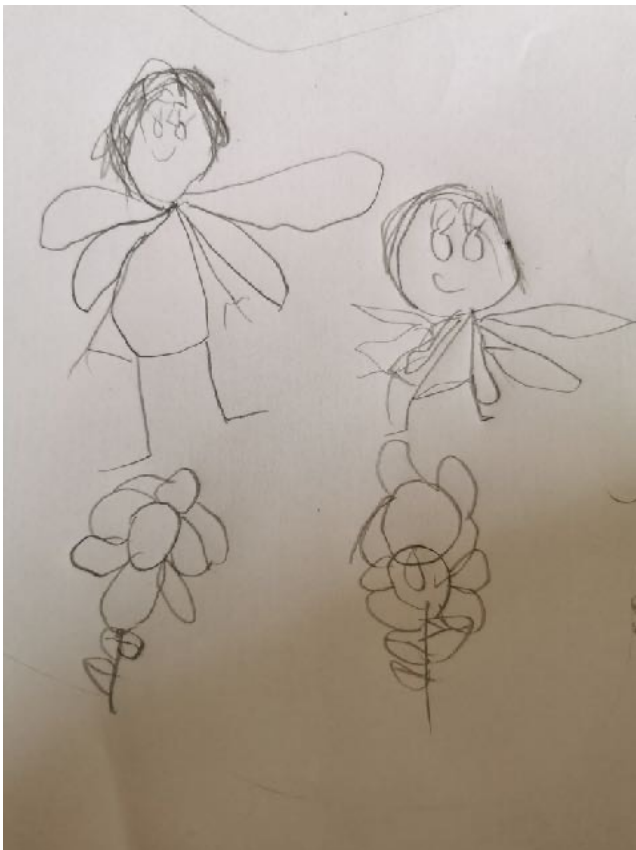


Entertaining family with a puppet show! She helped her Grandma to make and decorate the puppet theatre out of a big cardboard box.
