	Spelling Common Exception Words	Spelling patterns
Week 1	Parents	Adding –es to nouns and verbs ending in –y eg: (baby - babies, fly - flies, puppy - puppies)
Week 2	old and after	use suffixes -ness (formation of nouns), -ful, -less, -ment
Week 3	Grass and plant	Spell Year 2 homophones and near homophones. Won, one, see, sea, sun, son, there, their, two, too
Week 4	Sure and sugar	The ‘o’ sound spelt a after w and qu. watching, wander, want, squad, squabble, quantity.
Week 5	Cold and water	The /ɔ:/ sound spelt a before l and ll All, ball, small, falling, talking, stalk, tall.
Week 6	Move and prove	Adding –ing, to words of one syllable ending in a single consonant letter after a single short vowel letter (double the consonant) Hopping, sitting, rubbing, humming, popping, dropping.
