- copy, continue and create simple repeating patterns

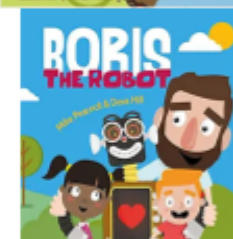
- Expressive Arts and Design
